



Safety Procedures for Spring Creek UMC Nursery

- **Nursery Staff will wear masks at all times. According to the CDC and Health and Human services, babies and children under the age of two should NOT wear masks, due to the risk of suffocation.
- *Parents will be asked to confirm that their child does not have a fever, shortness of breath or cough.
- * All nursery age children will have temperatures checked upon arrival. Children will NOT be allowed in the room with temperatures above 100.4 degrees. (contactless thermometer).
- *Children will either use hand sanitizer, hand wipes or wash their hands with soap and water upon arrival. (Staff will assist)
- *Changing table will be sanitized after each use. Staff will wash hands before and after diaper change, as well as the child's hands. (only child safe sanitizer will be used while children are in the room)
- *Staff will wash hands before and after feeding bottles. No other food or snacks will be offered.
- *Room and toys will be properly sanitized after children leave.
- *Toys that cannot be sanitized have been removed from the nursery.
- *Children drop-off will be outside the classroom, only essential staff will be allowed in the room.
- *All Staff, children and babies should remain at home if sick. This will protect the safety of Spring Creek staff and families.
